



**The Israeli Aggression on
Gaza Strip and the West Bank
Situation Report (No. 116)**

Covers the period from 29th to 31st January 2026

Introduction

Since October 7, 2023, the Israeli occupation has waged a genocidal war on the Gaza Strip, blatantly violating international law, including the 1948 Genocide Convention, which obligates state parties to pursue the enforcement of its prohibition. This onslaught has claimed tens of thousands of lives and left many more wounded.

Israeli occupation forces have blatantly violated the terms of the temporary ceasefire, resuming genocidal attacks on Gaza's civilian population with even greater intensity. Their renewed aggression has escalated dramatically, causing widespread destruction that has rendered the Strip uninhabitable. At the same time, they continue to enforce a suffocating blockade, starve the population, and forcibly displace thousands.

Meanwhile, the West Bank has seen a sharp escalation in violations, with increased assassinations, mass arrests, and settler attacks backed by the occupation army—part of broader ethnic cleansing and forced displacement policies. This report documents daily scenes in Gaza and the West Bank, highlighting crimes and attacks targeting Palestinians from January 29 to January 31, 2026. It also includes data on the consequences of the genocide since October 7, 2023.



Daily Scenes:

☐ | Thursday, January 29, 2026

The Israeli occupation authorities have continued their crimes in the Gaza Strip, with the death toll and number of wounded rising daily due to ongoing attacks and repeated violations of the ceasefire agreement. The documented toll of victims from the aggression is as follows:¹

Conclusion:¹⁴

The population of the Gaza Strip fell to approximately 2.13 million by the end of 2025, marking a decline of about 10.6% compared with figures recorded before October 7, 2023, amid the ongoing genocide.

Between January 29 and 31, 2026, Israeli occupation forces carried out attacks that killed 16 Palestinians, roughly 0.00075% of the territory's total population, averaging nearly five deaths per day over the three-day period. The same attacks injured 52 Palestinians, representing about 0.0024% of the population, with an average of approximately 17 injuries per day.

During that period, rescue teams also recovered the bodies of five additional victims from beneath the rubble.

These figures underscore the deepening humanitarian catastrophe facing Gaza's residents, as aggression, siege conditions, severe supply shortages, and collapsing infrastructure continue to drive extremely harsh living and health conditions.

Official population statistics show that the population of the West Bank reached approximately 3.43 million by the end of 2025.

Between January 29 and January 31, 2026, no deaths were recorded. However, the Israeli occupation army continued its military operations, injuring 14 citizens, about 0.00041% of the West Bank's total population with a daily average of roughly five injuries.

During the same period, the occupation army also arrested 36 citizens, representing approximately 0.00105% of the population, with a daily average of around 12 detainees. These figures reflect the continued escalation and increase in violations against civilians across various governorates of the West Bank.

Statistics show that 123 citizens were affected by Israeli attacks in the occupied Palestinian territories between January 29 and January 31, 2026. The attacks killed 16 citizens, all in the Gaza Strip, while no deaths were recorded in the West Bank. These 16 deaths represent approximately 0.00046% of the total population of the Palestinian territories, with a daily average of about five deaths over three days.

Israeli attacks also injured 66 citizens, 52 in the Gaza Strip and 14 in the West Bank, equivalent to roughly 0.00095% of the total population, with a daily average of around 22 injuries.

During the same period, the Israeli occupation army arrested 36 citizens, all from the West Bank, representing approximately 0.00052% of the population, with a daily average of about 12 detainees.

Rescue teams also recovered the bodies of five victims from beneath the rubble of destroyed buildings in the Gaza Strip. These recovered bodies account for about 0.00023% of Gaza's population, at a rate of nearly two per day, indicating that additional victims remain under the debris as bombardment continues.

In total, deaths, injuries, arrests, and recovered bodies brought the number of affected citizens to 123 during this period, approximately 0.00176% of the total population in the Palestinian territories, with a daily average of about 41 people affected. These figures highlight the continued escalation of violence and the ongoing targeting of civilians in the occupied Palestinian territories.
