



**Israeli Genocide in Gaza
Situation Report (No. 33)
on the Israeli Aggression on Gaza
Covers the period from 30th March to 3rd April 2024**

Introduction

This report covers the documentation of the genocide perpetrated by the Israeli occupation in the Gaza Strip. It encompasses monitoring and documenting daily scenes from March 30 to April 3, 2024, alongside documenting the political and humanitarian repercussions, as well as the material and human losses endured by the Gaza Strip due to ongoing aggression and siege. Additionally, it addresses the ramifications of the aggression in the West Bank, where citizens have faced assassination and arrest by Israeli occupation forces since October 7, 2023.

1. Daily Events:

▣ Saturday, March 30, 2024:

On Saturday, March 30, 2024, the Israeli occupation army continued its perpetration of massacres and genocide across the Gaza Strip. More than one massacre was documented, resulting in over 100 fatalities and approximately 140 injuries by Saturday evening. The Ministry of Health in Gaza reported that by Saturday morning, Israel had killed 82 individuals and injured 98 citizens in the Gaza Strip due to eight massacres committed by the Israeli army against civilians. This brings the total number of victims to 32,705 deaths and 75,190 wounded since October 7, 2023, marking the 176th day of the genocide perpetrated by the Israeli army.

The daily scenes disprove the Israeli occupation's claims of safe areas in the Gaza Strip, as bombardment affected various areas, including the neighborhoods of Zeitoun and Rimal in Gaza City, Khan Yunis, Rafah in the south, and shelling targeting Al-Nusirat and Al-Maghazi camps in the middle of the Strip. The Israeli occupation targeted displaced individuals and the health system, with documented destruction of residential buildings near the Nasser Medical Complex in Khan Yunis and continued artillery shelling around al-Shifa Medical



Complex in Gaza City. The day saw an escalation of attacks on the al-Shifa Complex, including executions, arrests, torture, and forced displacement of residents, including those previously displaced to the complex and its surroundings.

In the West Bank, the Israeli occupation army persisted in its policy of systematic killing, with documented cases including the murder of a Palestinian child due to the occupation army's aggression against the town of Qabatia in the north. This brought the total number of victims in the West Bank to 455 deaths and 4,750 wounded from October 7, 2023, to March 30, 2024.

■ Sunday, March 31, 2024:

On Sunday, March 31, 2024, the Israeli occupation army persisted in committing massacres and genocide across all parts of the Gaza Strip. Multiple massacres were documented, resulting in the loss of 80 lives and injuries to approximately 115 citizens by Sunday evening, amidst the ongoing genocide perpetrated by the Israeli occupation.



The Ministry of Health in Gaza reported 77 deaths and 108 wounded citizens in the Gaza Strip as of Sunday morning, stemming from 8 atrocities committed by the Israeli army against civilians, bringing the total number of victims to 32,782 deaths and 75,298 wounded from October 7, 2023, to March 31, 2024, marking the 177th day of the genocide perpetrated by the Israeli army. Daily scenes on this day further debunked the Israeli occupation's claims regarding the existence of safe areas in the Gaza Strip. Bombardment encompassed various areas, including the Zeitoun neighbourhood, al-Shifa Medical Complex and its surroundings

in Gaza City, as well as shelling in the Wadi Gaza area, Deir al-Balah, Al-Maghazi, and Al-Nusirat camps in the middle of the Gaza Strip, and Rafah and Khan Yunis in the south.

In the context of the genocide committed by the Israeli army in the Gaza Strip, Israeli forces continued targeting displaced individuals and the health system. The attack on al-Shifa hospital, subjected to incursions and artillery shelling, witnessed field executions by Israeli soldiers. Additionally, the Israeli army targeted Shuhada' Alaqsa Hospital and bombed journalists' tents in its vicinity. Aggression against Al-Amal and Nasser hospitals in Khan Yunis persisted.

The targeting of displaced individuals continued with the aim of forced displacement in the Gaza Strip. Artillery shelling and gunfire from Israeli army gunboats towards displaced camps and the chalets area in front of Khan Yunis

port were documented. This occurred alongside the continued destruction of civilian facilities, including the observed destruction of residential buildings east of the city of Khan Yunis, as a result of land incursions in the Strip.

In the West Bank, the occupation army maintained its policy of systematic killing. The assassination of a Palestinian citizen from the town of Dura, Hebron, was documented as a result of being targeted with live bullets, bringing the total number of victims in the West Bank to 456 deaths and 4,750 wounded from October 7, 2023, to March 31, 2024.



Monday, April 1, 2024



Monday, April 1, 2024, saw the Israeli occupation army persisting in committing massacres and genocide across all parts of the Gaza Strip. Multiple massacres were documented, resulting in the loss of 73 lives and injuries to about 110 citizens by Monday evening, amidst the ongoing genocide perpetrated by the Israeli occupation.

The Ministry of Health in Gaza reported 63 deaths and 94 wounded citizens in the Gaza Strip as of Monday morning, stemming from 6 crimes committed by the Israeli army against civilians. This brings the total number of victims to 32,845 deaths and 75,392 wounded from October 7, 2023, to April 1, 2024, marking the 178th day of the genocide perpetrated by the Israeli army.

Daily scenes on this day further discredited the Israeli occupation's claims regarding the existence of safe areas in the Gaza Strip.

Bombardment encompassed various areas, including the healing complex and its surroundings, the Al-Daraj Quarter, and the Al-Shati camp in Gaza City. The Israeli army targeted the city of Assra-Prisoners in the middle of the strip, and in the south, Israel attacked the cities of Rafah, Khan Yunis, and Khaza'a.

In the framework of the genocide committed by the Israeli army in the Gaza Strip, Israeli forces continued to target displaced individuals and the health system. Aggression targeting the Healing Medical Complex over 14 days resulted in the deaths of 400 deaths, the burning of entire sections of the hospital, and the destruction of all medical equipment and supplies. An attack on the Shuhada' Alaqsa Hospital resulted in the killing of 4 citizens and the injury of 15 others due to the targeting of a tent inside the hospital.

Regarding the targeting of displaced persons, a gathering near the Masjid Ibn Taymiyah in the Brazil neighborhood, southeast of Rafah city, resulted in the killing of 6 individuals and many wounded. An airstrike targeting the ground near the tents of the displaced in the Muharrat area near Al-Aqsa University west of Khan Yunis city also caused many injuries.



■ Tuesday, April 2, 2024

On Tuesday, April 2, 2024, the Israeli occupation army continued to commit massacres and genocide across all parts of the Gaza Strip. Multiple massacres were documented, resulting in 75 deaths and approximately 120 citizens injured by Tuesday evening, amidst the ongoing genocide perpetrated by the Israeli occupation.



The Ministry of Health in Gaza reported 71 deaths and 102 wounded citizens in the Gaza Strip as of Tuesday morning, stemming from 7 crimes committed by the Israeli army against civilians. This brings the total number of victims to 32,916 deaths and 75,494 wounded from October 7, 2023, to April 2, 2024, marking the 179th day of the genocide perpetrated by the Israeli army.

Daily scenes on this day further discredited the Israeli occupation's claims regarding the existence of safe areas in the Gaza Strip. Bombardment encompassed various areas, including Gaza City, Deir al-Balah, and Al-Nusirat camp in the middle of the Gaza Strip, as well as Rafah and Khan Yunis in the south.

In the framework of the genocide committed by the Israeli army in the Gaza Strip, Israeli forces continued to target humanitarian organizations. The assassination of 7 employees of the World Central Kitchen Organization in the city of Deir al-Balah in the

middle of the Gaza Strip was documented, including 6 foreigners of Australian, Polish, British, Canadian, American, Irish nationalities, and a Palestinian resident of the Rafah city.

In the West Bank, the occupation army continued its policy of systematic killing, a Palestinian citizen from the towns of Qabatiya and Jenin died as a result of injuries sustained during the occupation's aggression against the town. This brought the total number of victims in the West Bank to 457 deaths and 4,750 wounded from October 7, 2023, to April 2, 2024.

Wednesday, April 3, 2024

On Wednesday, April 3, 2024, the Israeli occupation army continued perpetrating massacres and genocide throughout the Gaza Strip. Multiple massacres were documented, resulting in 65 deaths and approximately 100 citizens injured by Wednesday evening, amidst the ongoing genocide perpetrated by the Israeli occupation.

The Ministry of Health in Gaza reported 59 deaths and 83 wounded citizens in the Gaza Strip as of Wednesday morning, stemming from 5 massacres committed by the Israeli army against civilians. This brings the total number of victims to 32,975 deaths and 75,577 wounded from October 7, 2023, to April 3, 2024, marking the 180th day of the genocide perpetrated by the Israeli army.

Daily scenes on this day further discredited the Israeli occupation's claims regarding the existence of safe areas in the Gaza Strip. Bombardment encompassed various areas, including Gaza City, Rafah, and Khan Yunis in the south, as well as Al-Nusirat Camp, Deir al-Balah, Madinat al-Zahra, and the Al Mughraqa town in the middle of the Strip.



In the context of the genocide committed by the Israeli army in the Gaza Strip, Israeli forces continued targeting the health system. A Palestinian killed as a result of a drone strike near El-Najar Hospital east of Rafah city, and violent aerial bombardment was observed in the vicinity of Nasser Complex in Khan Yunis. Regarding the targeting of the displaced, 4 injuries were documented, including a serious condition for a child as a result of drone firing on the tents of the displaced in the Al-Mawasi area west of Khan Yunis.

2. Political and Humanitarian Repercussions:

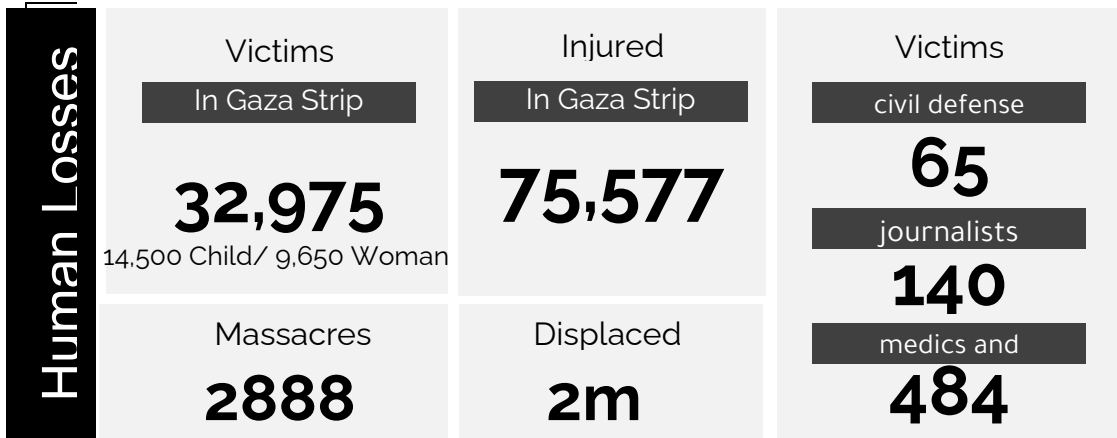


The period covered by this report unveiled the results of the aggression that al-Shifa Medical Complex endured over two weeks. In this context, more than 400 deaths were executed in al-Shifa Complex and its surroundings. The Israeli army attempted to conceal its crime by covering the bodies of the deaths with sand and burying them on the floor of the complex. Additionally, the arrest of more than 300 citizens was documented, and the aggression led to the disappearance of 100 Palestinian citizens whose fate remains unknown.

Regarding the continued exploitation of humanitarian aid by the occupation as a tool of genocide, the Israeli army persisted in targeting citizens while attempting to obtain aid. As of March 30, 2024, the murder of 563 citizens and the injury of 1523 others during attacks deliberately targeting aid distribution centers, workers, and those responsible for organizing and protecting aid distribution in the Gaza Strip have been documented.

3. Human Loss and Material Damage:

The number of deaths in the Gaza Strip increased from October 7, 2023, to April 3, 2024, reaching 32,975, including 14,500 children. Among these, 30 children succumbed to famine-related conditions. Additionally, there were 9,650 women martyred, 484 from medical teams, 65 from



civil defense, and 140 journalists. The number of wounded reached 75,577, with 7,000 reported missing, of which 70% were children and women. The number of displaced people rose to 2 million. The occupation army committed over 2,922 massacres. Regarding detainees from the Gaza Strip, 310 medical personnel and 12 journalists were arrested since the ground invasion on October 27, 2023, totaling over 4,000 arrests by April 3, 2024.

Infrastructure destruction includes 171 government buildings demolished, 100 schools and universities rendered unusable, and 305 schools and universities partially damaged. Additionally, 229 mosques were completely destroyed, 297 partially demolished, and 3 churches destroyed. Residential units were affected, with 70,000 demolished and 290,000 partially destroyed.

Furthermore, 200 archaeological and heritage sites were destroyed, with over 70,000 tons of explosives used.

The Israeli army targeted 32 hospitals and 53 health centers, taking them out of service, and attacked 159 health institutions, affecting health services. Moreover, 126 ambulances were completely damaged.

Consequences of aid prevention include 700,000 cases of infectious diseases, 8,000 cases of viral hepatitis, 10,000 untreated cancer cases, 60,000 pregnant women lacking healthcare, and 350,000 chronic disease cases.


Material Losses




In the West Bank, 457 deaths and over 4,750 wounded were reported, with 7,619 prisoners. Forced displacement affected around 3,985 individuals, with 648 facilities demolished. These numbers reflect the consequences of the genocide perpetrated by the Israeli occupation in the Gaza Strip from October 7, 2023, to April 3, 2024.
