


Israeli Genocide in Gaza Situation Report (No. 36) on the Israeli Aggression on Gaza Covers the period from 24th April to 3rd May 2024

Introduction

This report documents the genocide committed by the Israeli occupation in the Gaza Strip, monitoring and documenting daily scenes, covering the period from April 24 to May 5, 2024. It also examines the political and humanitarian repercussions, and the material and human loss the Gaza Strip is suffering due to ongoing aggression and siege, particularly under the restrictions imposed on the entry of aid into the Gaza Strip. Additionally, the report addresses the consequences of the aggression in the West Bank, where citizens have been subjected to assassination and arrest by Israeli occupation forces since October 7, 2023



1. Daily Scenes:

Wednesday, April 24, 2024

On Wednesday, April 24, 2024, the Israeli occupation army continued to commit massacres throughout the Gaza Strip. Several massacres were documented, resulting in 83 deaths and 86 wounded by Wednesday evening, amid the ongoing genocide committed by the Israeli occupation in the Gaza Strip.

The Ministry of Health in Gaza announced 79 deaths and 86



wounded in the Gaza Strip as of Wednesday morning, due to six massacres committed by the occupation army against civilians in the Strip. This raised the total number of victims to 34,262 deaths and 77,229 wounded from October 7, 2023, to April 24, 2024.

On the 201st day of the genocide carried out by the occupation army, daily scenes demonstrated the falsity of the occupation's claims regarding the existence of safe areas in the Gaza Strip. Ground, air, and sea bombardments included various areas of the Strip, including the neighborhoods of Al-Zaytoun and Al-Shuja'iya and Al-Jalaa Street in Gaza City, Beit Lahia, Jabalia, Beit Hanoun in the north, Al-Nuseirat camp, Al-Zawaida, Bureij in the center, and Khan Yunis and Rafah in the south.

Wednesday also saw the recovery of more bodies of deaths. It was documented that nine deaths were recovered from various places in Khan Yunis, totaling 324 deaths recovered, 30 of whom were identified. Additionally, 51 bodies were recovered from the vicinity of the Nasser Medical Complex.

In the West Bank, the occupation forces continued their policy of systematic killing. The assassination of a Palestinian woman was documented in the city of Hebron after she was directly targeted with live bullets. This raised the number of victims in the West Bank to 490 deaths and 4,800 wounded from October 7, 2023, to April 24, 2024.

Thursday, April 25, 2024



On Thursday, April 25, 2024, the Israeli occupation army continued to commit massacres throughout the Gaza Strip. Several massacres were documented, resulting in 55 deaths and 64 wounded by Thursday evening, as the genocide committed by the Israeli occupation in the Gaza Strip persisted.

The Ministry of Health in Gaza announced 43 deaths and 64 injuries in the Gaza Strip as of Thursday morning, due to five massacres committed by the occupation army against civilians in the Strip. This raised the total number of victims to 34,305 deaths and 77,293 wounded from October 7, 2023, to April 25, 2024.

On the 202nd day of the genocide carried out by the occupation army, daily scenes demonstrated the falsity of the occupation's claims regarding the existence of safe areas in the Gaza Strip. Land, air, and sea bombardments targeted various areas of the Strip, including the neighborhoods of Sheikh Ijlin, Tel Al-Hawa,



and Al-Zaytoun in Gaza City, as well as Al-Mughraqa, Al-Nuseirat, and Deir al-Balah in the central Strip. Yabna camp, Al-Fukhari, Al-Mawasi areas, and Khan Yunis in the south were also affected.

On Thursday, the health system continued to be deliberately targeted. It was documented that the vicinity of the Indonesian Hospital in the northern Gaza Strip was attacked, resulting in the death of three children due to missiles launched by a reconnaissance plane towards the hospital's surroundings.

In the West Bank, the occupation forces continued their policy of systematic killing. The assassination of a Palestinian child, a resident of Jenin, was documented in the city of Ramallah after he was directly targeted with live bullets during the occupation army's storming of the city. This raised the number of victims in the West Bank to 491 deaths and 4,800 wounded from October 7, 2023, to April 25, 2024.

Friday, April 26, 2024

On Friday, April 26, 2024, the Israeli occupation army continued to commit massacres throughout the Gaza Strip. Several massacres were documented, resulting in 55 deaths and 75 wounded by Friday evening, as the genocide committed by the Israeli occupation in the Gaza Strip persisted.

The Ministry of Health in Gaza announced 51 deaths and 75 injuries in the Gaza Strip as of Friday morning, due to five massacres committed by the occupation army against civilians in the Strip. This raised the total number of victims to 34,356 deaths and

77,368 wounded from October 7, 2023, to April 26, 2024.

On the 203rd day of the genocide carried out by the occupation army, daily scenes proved the falsity of the occupation's claims regarding the existence of safe areas in the Gaza Strip. Land, air, and sea bombardments targeted various areas of the Strip, including the neighborhoods of Al-Zaytoun, Al-Tuffah, Al-Shuja'iya, and Tel Al-Hawa in Gaza City, as well as Al-Mughraqa, the Wadi Gaza Bridge area, and Bureij and Al-Nuseirat camps in the central Gaza Strip. Khuza'a, Khan



Yunis, Rafah in the south, and the vicinity of the Indonesian Hospital in the north were also affected.

As part of the strategy of forced displacement and attacking international institutions, Friday witnessed the targeting of the vicinity of the "Faisal" School in Khan Yunis, resulting in the death of three deaths. Additionally, three bodies were recovered from a house sheltering displaced people in Gaza City. Regarding the targeting of organizations working in the humanitarian field, the Red Cross headquarters in Gaza City was attacked, resulting in several deaths and wounded.

Concerning the mass graves uncovered at the Nasser Medical Complex, three mass graves were monitored, and as of April 26, 2024, about 392 bodies had been documented, including 165 unidentified bodies. Identification was hindered due to the occupation deliberately altering identifying features and mutilating the bodies.

Saturday, April 27, 2024

On Saturday, April 27, 2024, the Israeli occupation army continued to commit massacres throughout the Gaza Strip. Several massacres were documented, resulting in 40 deaths and 69 wounded by Saturday evening, amid the ongoing genocide committed by the Israeli occupation in the Gaza Strip.

The Ministry of Health in Gaza announced 32 deaths and 69 injuries in the Gaza Strip as of Saturday morning, due to four massacres committed by the occupation army against civilians in the Strip. This raised the total number of victims to 34,388 deaths and 77,437 wounded from October 7, 2023, to April 27, 2024.

On the 204th day of the genocide carried out by the occupation army, daily scenes demonstrated the falsity of the occupation's claims regarding the existence of safe areas in the Gaza Strip. Ground, air, and sea bombardments targeted various areas of the

Strip, including Al-Wehda Street and the Al-Shuja'iya neighborhood in Gaza City, as well as Al-Nuseirat, Madinat al-Zahraa, and Al-Mughraga in the central Strip. Beit Lahia in the north and Rafah and Khan Yunis in the south were also affected.

As a result of the continued ground invasion of the Gaza Strip, Saturday witnessed violent bombing and destruction of civilian facilities, particularly in the eastern areas of Rafah in the south, and the towns of Al-Mughraqa and Al-Zawaida in the central Gaza Strip. Artillery shelling was also documented in the northern areas of the Gaza Strip and the Al-Zaytoun neighborhood in Gaza City.

In the West Bank, the occupation forces continued their policy of systematic killing. The assassination of two Palestinian citizens from the towns of Kafar Dan and Silat al-Harithiya in the Jenin Governorate was documented after they were targeted near the Salem military checkpoint, close to the Rummana Junction, west of the city. This raised the number of victims in the West Bank to 493 deaths and 4,800 wounded from October 7, 2023, to April 27, 2024.

Sunday, April 28, 2024

On Sunday, April 28, 2024, the Israeli occupation army continued to commit massacres throughout the Gaza Strip. Several massacres were documented, resulting in 67 deaths and 138 wounded by Sunday evening, amid the ongoing genocide committed by the Israeli occupation in the Gaza Strip. The Ministry of Health in Gaza announced 66 deaths and 138 injuries in the Gaza Strip as of Sunday morning, due to seven massacres committed by the occupation army against civilians in the Strip. This raised the total number of victims to 34,454 deaths and 77,575 wounded from October 7, 2023, to April 28, 2024.



On the 205th day of the genocide carried out by the occupation army, daily scenes demonstrated the falsity of the occupation's claims regarding the existence of safe areas in the Gaza Strip. Ground, air, and sea bombardments targeted various areas of the Strip, including the Al-Zaytoun neighborhood in Gaza City, the towns of Khuza'a and Al-Fukhari, and the cities of Rafah and Khan Younis in the south, as well as Al-Nuseirat and Bureij camps and the towns of Al-Zawaida and Al-Mughraqa in the central Strip. Regarding the continued targeting of displaced people and the health system, to impose forced displacement on the residents of the Gaza Strip, Sunday witnessed the bombing of a house housing several displaced people in Al-Shaboura camp in central Rafah, resulting in the death of six displaced deaths. In terms of targeting the health system, it was announced that the public health laboratory had closed and was unable to test drinking water due to the occupation forces preventing the entry of chlorine or any alternative to treat drinking water.

Monday, April 29, 2024

On Monday, April 29, 2024, the Israeli occupation army continued to commit massacres throughout the Gaza Strip. Several massacres were documented, resulting in 45 deaths and 68 wounded by Monday evening, as the genocide committed by the

Israeli occupation in the Gaza Strip persisted. The Ministry of Health in Gaza announced 34 deaths and 68 injuries in the Gaza Strip as of Monday morning, due to three massacres committed by the occupation army against civilians in the Strip. This raised the total number of victims to 34,488 deaths and 77,643 wounded from October 7, 2023, to April 29, 2024.

On the 206th day of the genocide carried out by the occupation army, daily scenes demonstrated the falsity of



the occupation's claims regarding the existence of safe areas in the Gaza Strip. Land, air, and sea bombardments targeted various areas of the Strip, including the Al-Sabra neighborhood and the Al-Shati camp in Gaza City, the cities of Rafah and Khan Yunis, the Brazil neighborhood, and Al-Shaboura camp in the south, Al-Nuseirat camp and Juhr al-Dik area in the central Strip, and Jabalia and Beit Lahia camp in the north.

Regarding the continued deliberate targeting of displaced persons to impose forced displacement on the residents of the Gaza Strip, an aerial bombardment affected agricultural land next to the tents of the displaced in the vicinity of the "Amwaj" hall, west of Rafah. An attack also targeted a house sheltering a group of displaced people in Al-Shaboura, central Rafah, resulting in seven deaths.

Monday witnessed the documentation of another type of war crime against humanity committed by the occupation army. The issue of occupation soldiers booby-trapping food cans was raised, prompting warnings to citizens not to approach remnants left by the occupation army, which are intentionally set as ambushes. This tactic has resulted in numerous deaths and injuries, according to official statements issued by the government media office in Gaza.

Tuesday, April 30, 2024

On Tuesday, April 30, 2024, the Israeli occupation army continued to commit massacres throughout the Gaza Strip. Several massacres were documented, resulting in dozens of deaths and wounded amid the ongoing genocide committed by the Israeli occupation in the Gaza Strip.

The Ministry of Health in Gaza announced 47 deaths and 61 injuries in the Gaza Strip as of Tuesday morning, due to five massacres committed by the occupation army against civilians in the Strip. This raised the total number of victims to 34,535 deaths and 77,704 wounded from October 7, 2023, to April 30, 2024.

On the 207th day of the genocide carried out by the occupation army, daily scenes demonstrated the falsity of the occupation's claims regarding the existence of safe areas in the Gaza Strip. Ground, air, and sea bombardments targeted various areas of the Strip, including the Al-Daraj Quarter in Gaza City, the Jabalia camp in the north, Al-Nuseirat camp, and the Al-Masdar area in central Gaza. The neighborhoods of Al-Amal, Tel Al-Sultan, the Sahel area in Rafah, and the Ma'an area in Khan Yunis in the south were also affected.



Regarding the continued deliberate targeting of displaced persons to impose forced displacement on the residents of the Gaza Strip, an air strike targeted tents for displaced persons in Rafah. Additionally, the occupation army continued to restrict the livelihood of citizens in the Gaza Strip by targeting a water tank in the Abu Halawa area, east of Rafah.

In the West Bank, the occupation forces continued their policy of systematic killing. The assassination of a Palestinian citizen was documented after he was arrested and assaulted by occupation soldiers while on his way to work near the town of Al-Dhahiriya, south of Hebron. This raised the number of victims in the West Bank to 494 deaths and 4,800 wounded from October 7, 2023, to April 30, 2024.

Wednesday, May 1, 2024



On Wednesday, May 1, 2024, the Israeli occupation army continued to commit massacres throughout the Gaza Strip. Several massacres were documented, resulting in 40 deaths and 57 wounded by Wednesday evening, amid the ongoing genocide committed by the Israeli occupation in the Gaza Strip.

The Ministry of Health in Gaza announced 33 deaths and 57 injuries in the Gaza Strip as of Wednesday morning, due to four massacres

committed by the occupation army against civilians in the Strip. This raised the total number of victims to 34,568 deaths and 77,765 wounded from October 7, 2023, to May 1, 2024. On the 208th day of the genocide carried out by the occupation army, daily scenes demonstrated the falsity of the occupation's claims regarding the existence of safe areas in the Gaza Strip. Ground, air, and sea bombardments targeted various areas of the Strip, including Al-Jalaa Street and the neighborhoods of Tel Al-Hawa, Al-Sabra, and Al-Shuja'iya in Gaza City, Al-Nuseirat camp, Madinat al-Zahraa, and Deir al-Balah in the center of the Strip, and Beit Lahia in the north.

Regarding the continued deliberate targeting of displaced people to impose forced displacement on the residents of the Gaza Strip, on Wednesday, the occupation forces targeted a house sheltering a group of displaced people in Al-Shaboura camp in central Rafah, resulting in the death of two children. In the same context, it was documented that occupation soldiers opened fire on two citizens after detaining them while they were trying to return from the southern to the northern Gaza Strip via Salah al-Din Street.

Thursday, May 2, 2024

On Thursday, May 2, 2024, the Israeli occupation army continued to commit massacres throughout the Gaza Strip. Several massacres were documented, resulting in 35 deaths and 70 wounded by Thursday evening, amid the ongoing genocide committed by the Israeli occupation in the Gaza Strip.

The Ministry of Health in Gaza announced 28 deaths and 51 injuries in the Gaza Strip as of Thursday morning, due to three massacres committed by the occupation army against civilians in the Strip. This raised the total number of victims to 34,596 deaths and 77,816 wounded from October 7, 2023, to May 2, 2024.

On the 209th day of the genocide carried out by the occupation army, daily scenes proved the falsity of the occupation's claims regarding the existence of safe areas in the Gaza Strip. Land, air, and sea bombardments targeted various areas of the Strip, including the neighborhoods of Al-Zaytoun, Al-Shuja'iya, Sheikh Ijlin, and Tel Al-Hawa in Gaza City. In the south of the Gaza Strip, the occupation army targeted the Qaa al-Qurain area, the city of Khan Yunis, the vicinity of the destroyed Gaza



International Airport, the town of Al-Shoka, and the Al-Tanour neighborhood, east of Rafah. The Al-Zawaida area and Al-Nuseirat camp in the central Strip also experienced bombardments, along with Jabalia in the north.

Regarding the continued targeting of displaced people and the health system, the occupation forces targeted a house housing displaced people near Al-Attar Mosque, west of Rafah. In terms of repercussions on the health system, Thursday witnessed the release of two medical staff members from occupation prisons after they had been kidnapped earlier. Additionally, it was documented that aid trucks were targeted with live bullets at the Kuwait Roundabout in Gaza City, highlighting the ongoing targeting of humanitarian aid.

Friday, May 3, 2024



On Friday, May 3, 2024, the Israeli occupation army continued to commit massacres throughout the Gaza Strip. Several massacres were documented, resulting in 28 deaths and 51 wounded by Friday evening, amid the ongoing genocide committed by the Israeli occupation in the Gaza Strip. The Ministry of Health in Gaza announced 26 deaths and 51 injuries in the Gaza Strip as of Friday morning, due to three massacres committed by the occupation army against civilians in the Strip.

This raised the total number of victims to 34,622 deaths and 77,867 wounded from October 7, 2023, to May 3, 2024. On the 210th day of the genocide carried out by the occupation army, daily scenes demonstrated the falsity of the occupation's claims regarding the existence of safe areas in the Gaza Strip. Ground, air, and sea bombardments targeted various areas of the Strip, a including Al-Nafaq Street and the Kuwait Roundabout in Gaza City, Bureij and Al-Nuseirat camps in the middle of the Strip, Al-Salam neighborhood, Rafah city and crossing in the south, and East Jabalia in the north. Regarding the continued targeting of displaced people, Friday witnessed the documentation of a bombing targeting the tents of displaced people west of Rafah Governorate, resulting in the killing of a girl and the wounding of more than 15 citizens. Additionally, the occupation forces targeted aid trucks near the Kuwait Roundabout, resulting in the death of a truck driver and

injuries to others. A sudden collapse of a partially destroyed house was also documented after planes dropped an aid parachute that fell on the house, northwest of Gaza City, causing casualties, including deaths and wounded.

2. Political and Humanitarian Repercussions:

During the period covered by this report, several mass graves were discovered, revealing attempts by the occupation army to conceal its crimes. These graves contained the bodies of hundreds of civilians executed by the occupation forces and hidden in the ground. Many of these bodies could not be identified due to intentional changes and distortions to their features. Given this grim reality, it is imperative to conduct comprehensive investigations into the circumstances surrounding the assassination and burial of civilians. These graves serve as evidence of the commission of the crime of genocide.

In a related context of the occupation army committing war crimes against humanity, there are indications that the occupation forces may be using thermal weapons. These weapons generate intense heat, leading to the vaporization of victims' bodies during widespread attacks. It is important to emphasize that this is not mere speculation but based on preliminary information that sheds light on the horrific levels of killing and genocide perpetrated by the occupation authorities in the Gaza Strip. Turning to the humanitarian repercussions, the occupation authorities persisted in restricting the work of relief institutions, targeting their staff, impeding their operations, and controlling the distribution of food to Gaza's citizens. These actions have left many without achieving adequate levels of food security. It is crucial to underscore that these practices constitute crimes

warranting accountability, particularly as they contravene measures outlined by the International Court of Justice, UN Security Council resolutions, and relevant international statements.

3. Human Loss and Material Damage:

The toll of human lives in the Gaza Strip from October 7, 2023, to May 3, 2024, reached 34,622 deaths, tragically including 14,944 children, among them 30 children who succumbed to famine, as well as 9,849 women. Additionally, 492 medical personnel, 68 civil defense personnel, and 144 journalists were martyred. The number

of wounded individuals stood at 77,867, with 10,000 people reported missing, of whom 70% are children and women. The displacement crisis worsened, with the number of displaced people soaring to 2 million. The occupation army's atrocities were starkly evident, with documented cases of over 3,070 massacres.

In terms of detentions, 310 medical personnel and 20 journalists were arrested during the ground invasion of the Gaza Strip starting October 27, 2023, adding to a total of over 5,000 arrests as of May 3, 2024.

Infrastructure bore the brunt of the destruction, with 184 government headquarters, 103 schools and universities rendered completely inoperative, and 311 educational institutions partially damaged. Mosques suffered greatly, with 243 completely demolished and 321 partially destroyed, alongside the destruction of three churches. Residential units suffered immensely, with 86,000 completely demolished and 294,000 partially damaged. Additionally, 206 archaeological sites were destroyed, all due to over 75,000 tons of explosives.

Hospitals were not spared, with 32 hospitals and 53 health centers rendered inoperative. Moreover, 160 health institutions were



targeted, affecting healthcare provision, and 126 ambulances were completely damaged.

The blockade and targeting of aid and medicines led to a dire health crisis, with 1,095,000 cases of infectious diseases, 20,000 cases of viral hepatitis, 10,000 untreated cases of cancer, 60,000 pregnant women lacking healthcare, and 350,000 cases of chronic diseases.

In the West Bank, 494 deaths, over 4,950 wounded, and 8,088 prisoners were reported. The forced displacement process affected approximately 3,985 individuals, with about 648 facilities demolished. These figures represent the harrowing consequences of the Israeli occupation's genocide in the Gaza Strip from October 7, 2023, to May 3, 2024.
