


Introduction

This report details the genocide perpetrated by Israeli forces in the Gaza Strip, covering daily scenes from May 4 to May 13, 2024. It also examines the political and humanitarian repercussions, as well as the material and human losses endured by the Gaza Strip due to the ongoing aggression and blockade. Additionally, the report addresses the ramifications of the aggression in the West Bank since October 7, 2023.



1. Daily Scenes



The occupation army has continued to perpetrate massacres and crimes in the Gaza Strip. Official Palestinian sources in the Strip have documented the following details regarding the number of massacres, victims, and wounded individuals:

In the latest developments concerning attempts to impose forced displacement and the continued targeting of displaced people, Saturday saw an attack near shelter centers by the "Noah" Mosque in the town of Al-Fukhari, east of Khan Yunis in the southern Gaza Strip. This resulted in civilian casualties at the targeted location.

In the West Bank, occupation forces maintained their policy of systematic killing. The assassination of five Palestinian citizens from Tulkarm was documented after they were besieged in a building, which was then targeted with live bullets and explosives. This raised the total number of victims in the West Bank to 498 deaths and 4,950 wounded from October 7, 2023, to May 4, 2024.

Sunday, May 5, 2024

The occupation army has continued to commit massacres and crimes in the Gaza Strip. Official Palestinian sources have documented the number of massacres, deaths, and wounded victims as follows:

Regarding the continued targeting of displaced people and the health system, several intense airstrikes were monitored targeting neighborhoods west of Rafah, where many displaced people are present. Additionally, an airstrike targeting a house near the European Hospital south of Khan Yunis was documented, resulting in its complete destruction.

In relation to discovered mass graves and the ongoing recovery of bodies, on Sunday, May 5, 2024, civil defense crews recovered five decomposed bodies of victims from the Al-Jabari family, whose house had been targeted near the Palestine Stadium in Gaza City.

Regarding the consequences of imposing restrictions and bans on the entry of humanitarian aid by land, casualties occurred on Monday due to the continued random approach to delivering aid. Five casualties were documented during citizens' attempts to obtain air-dropped aid northwest of Gaza City.

In terms of the ongoing attempts to impose forced displacement on citizens in the Gaza Strip, the targeting of the "Al-Jaouni" school, which houses displaced persons in Al-Nuseirat camp, was documented, resulting in the death of six individuals. Additionally, the occupation aircraft dropped threatening leaflets on citizens in Rafah to displace them from the area, coinciding with violent aerial bombardments.

In the West Bank, the occupation forces continued their policy of systematic killing, as evidenced by the assassination of a Palestinian citizen who was targeted with live bullets during the storming of Tulkarm camp. This brought the total number of victims in the West Bank to 498 deaths and 4,950 wounded from October 7, 2023, to May 6, 2024.

Tuesday, May 7, 2024

The occupation army has continued to commit massacres and crimes in the Gaza Strip. Official Palestinian sources have documented the following details regarding the number of massacres, deaths, and wounded victims:

On Tuesday, the occupation forces took control of the Rafah land border crossing with Egypt and completely closed it, halting the movement of sick and wounded travelers and preventing the entry of aid into the Strip. In addition to the occupation of the Rafah crossing, the entry of humanitarian aid through the Kerem Shalom border crossing was also stopped. This coincided with an observed expansion in the targeting of hospitals, health centers, schools, and shelter centers that house hundreds of thousands of displaced people.

On Wednesday, May 8, 2024, a third mass grave was discovered within al-Shifa Medical Complex in Gaza City. The grave yielded 49 bodies, including numerous medical, nursing, and administrative staff employed at the complex. Consequently, the total count of mass graves has risen to 8 across various locations. The number of deaths found in mass graves throughout the Gaza Strip has now reached 569.

Thursday, May 9, 2024

The occupation army continued committing massacres and crimes in the Gaza Strip that have been documented by official Palestinian sources. Details regarding the number of massacres, deaths, and wounded victims are as follows:

Regarding the developments in the situation concerning the ongoing closure of the Rafah crossing, the occupation forces have blocked the entry of over 400 trucks carrying aid, food, supplies, and medical equipment. Additionally, 159 cancer patients were barred from traveling, and the wounded were also prevented from seeking treatment in hospitals outside the Gaza Strip.

Friday, May 10, 2024

The occupation army persistently engaged in committing massacres and crimes in the Gaza Strip, as indicated by the documentation from official Palestinian sources.

Regarding developments in targeting the health system, the administration of Shuhada al-Aqsa Hospital in Deir al-Balah, Central of the Gaza Strip, has announced an imminent fuel shortage, leading to a halt in health services. This is particularly alarming as it is the last remaining hospital providing healthcare, following the destruction of the health sector and medical system by the occupation, rendering 33 hospitals fully out of service.

Saturday, May 11, 2024

The Israeli military presence persists in Gaza, with reports of ongoing atrocities and violations. Official Palestinian sources within the territory have documented the escalating toll, regarding the number of massacres, deaths, and wounded victims are as follows:

Sunday, May 12, 2024

Official Palestinian sources within the Gaza Strip have reported ongoing acts of violence and human rights abuses by the occupying military force. These sources have documented multiple incidents of massacres, along with the increasing toll of casualties, including both deaths and wounded victims.

In terms of forced displacement, reports indicate that tens of thousands of residents in the northern Gaza Strip have been compelled to leave their homes, with dozens of displaced persons' tents subjected to attacks. Incidents of targeting shelter centres in the Jabalia camp have also been documented, resulting in both victims and wounded individuals.

Moving to the West Bank, the occupation forces have persisted in their policy of systematic violence. An instance of this brutality was the documented assassination of a Palestinian citizen, who was targeted with live bullets during the incursion into Balata camp in Nablus. This tragic event adds to the grim tally, bringing the total number of victims in the West Bank from October 7, 2023, to May 12, 2024, to 501 deaths and 4,950 wounded.

Monday, May 13, 2024

The Gaza Strip remains a site of ongoing atrocities perpetrated by the occupying army, as confirmed by official Palestinian sources within the Gaza Strip. These sources have meticulously documented the number of massacres, along with the toll of deaths and wounded victims resulting from these heinous acts.

On Monday, May 13, 2024, significant incidents unfolded concerning forced displacement and the targeting of essential healthcare facilities. The European Hospital in Khan Yunis experienced a power outage attributed to the occupation's blockade on fuel imports. Additionally, reports documented an attack on the Bisan Medical Center in Bureij camp.

In terms of forced displacement efforts, the occupation forces besieged schools serving as shelters for thousands of displaced individuals in Jabalia camp. Amidst intense gunfire, the forces stormed these premises, forcing the displaced to evacuate while also making numerous arrests.

2. Political and Humanitarian Repercussions:

This report highlights a significant wave of forced displacement resulting from the occupation of the Rafah crossing. This action has displaced 400,000 citizens from Rafah in the southern Gaza Strip, forcing them into areas unfit for habitation due to the widespread destruction caused by ongoing military attacks. The humanitarian crisis has worsened due to the closure and occupation of crossings essential for delivering humanitarian aid.

Additionally, the occupation forces have stormed shelters in UNRWA schools in Jabalia, northern Gaza Strip, leading to the assassination and arrest of dozens of Palestinian citizens and forcing thousands to flee amidst air and artillery bombardment. The forces besieged thousands of displaced people in six UNRWA schools on Schools Street in Jabalia camp, maintaining the siege until they were compelled to move to unspecified locations.
