

Israeli Genocide in Gaza Situation Report (No. 38)

on the Israeli Aggression on Gaza

Covers the period from 14th to 23rd May 2024

Introduction

This report details the genocide perpetrated by the Israeli occupation in the Gaza Strip, monitoring and documenting daily scenes from May 14 to May 23, 2024. It also examines the political and humanitarian repercussions, as well as the material and human losses sustained by the Gaza Strip due to the continuous aggression and blockade. Furthermore, the report covers the consequences of the aggression in the West Bank since October 7, 2023.



1. Daily Scenes

Tuesday, May 14, 2024

The occupation army continued its campaign of massacres and atrocities in the Gaza Strip. Official Palestinian sources in the

region documented the following details concerning the number of massacres, as well as the deaths and wounded victims:

These massacres were documented throughout the Gaza Strip, which was subjected to air and ground bombardment, as follows:

he forced displacement and targeting of civilians continued on Tuesday, with the occupation army bombing a house filled with displaced people in Al-Nuseirat camp, central Gaza Strip, resulting in numerous deaths and injuries. Additionally, airstrikes were reported near tents housing displaced individuals west of Khan Yunis, southern Gaza Strip.

Wednesday, May 15, 2024

The occupation army persisted in its violent campaign in the Gaza Strip. Official Palestinian sources documented multiple massacres, recording the number of casualties and injuries as follows:

Significant destruction was reported on Wednesday, including demolishing entire residential blocks and destroying a health clinic and four schools in the Al-Zaytoun neighborhood. Destruction of civilian and health facilities in the northern Gaza Strip was also documented. An airstrike targeted a group of citizens on Al-Jalaa Street as they attempted to connect to the internet to contact their families.

In the West Bank, the occupation forces continued systematic killings. The assassination of a Palestinian from Jalazone camp occurred during the day of the Nakba commemoration protest at the northern entrance to Al-Bireh, bringing the total number of victims in the West Bank to 502 deaths and 5,000 wounded from October 7, 2023, to May 15, 2024.

Thursday, May 16, 2024

The occupation army persisted in its violent campaign in the Gaza Strip, with official Palestinian sources documenting multiple massacres, including the number of deaths and wounded:

On Thursday, the ongoing targeting of the health system was evident. The Kuwait Specialized Hospital in central Rafah was struck, resulting in five injuries and the destruction of two ambulances. In northern Gaza, ambulances belonging to Al-Awda Hospital were targeted. Additionally, a bombing near the European Hospital in Khan Yunis caused multiple casualties.

The occupation forces continued their systematic killings in the West Bank, with four Palestinians assassinated: three in Tulkarm and one in Ramallah, after being directly targeted. This brought the total number of victims in the West Bank to 506 deaths and 5,000 wounded from October 7, 2023, to May 16, 2024.

Friday, May 17, 2024

The occupation army continued its campaign of massacres and crimes in the Gaza Strip. Official Palestinian sources documented numerous massacres, including the number of deaths and wounded:

These incidents were recorded across the Gaza Strip, which faced both air and ground bombardment, as follows:

On Friday, the vicinity of Al-Yemen Hospital in Jabalia and Kamal Adwan Hospital in Beit Lahia were targeted. In addition, the "Al-Jaouni" school in Al-Nuseirat camp was attacked, resulting in the deaths of four citizens and dozens of injuries. The occupation navy also fired violently at tents housing displaced people on the seashore of Rafah, southern Gaza Strip.

Situation Report (No. 38) from May 14 to 23 May 2024

The occupation forces continued their policy of systematic killing in the West Bank, with assassinations of Palestinian citizens documented in Tulkarm and Jenin after direct targeting. This brought the total number of victims in the West Bank to 508 deaths and 5,000 wounded from October 7, 2023, to May 17, 2024.



Saturday, May 18, 2024

The occupation army continued its violent campaign in the Gaza Strip. Official Palestinian sources documented several massacres, detailing the number of deaths and wounded:

Regarding the ongoing targeting of displaced people, it was documented that the occupation forces attacked a shelter center at a UNRWA school, resulting in numerous casualties. Additionally, an airstrike near Kuwaiti Hospital in Rafah resulted in three injuries.

The occupation army persisted in committing massacres and crimes in the Gaza Strip. Official Palestinian sources documented several massacres, detailing the number of deaths and wounded:

In terms of targeting the health system and displaced individuals, it was documented that thousands of citizens at Al-Yemen Al-Saeed Hospital, and the "Abu Hussein" and "Abu Rashid" schools, were forced to flee again amid extensive shootings targeting the displaced.

The occupation forces continued their policy of systematic killing. The assassination of a Palestinian in the village of Abu Dis, east of Jerusalem, was documented after he was directly targeted. This brought the total number of victims in the West Bank to 509 deaths and 5,000 wounded from October 7, 2023, to May 19, 2024.

Monday, May 20, 2024

The occupation army continued its violent campaign in the Gaza Strip. Official Palestinian sources documented several massacres, detailing the number of deaths and wounded:

Concerning the targeting of the health system and ongoing attempts to enforce forced displacement, artillery shelling was documented at Al-Awda Hospital in the Tal al-Zaatar area of the northern Gaza Strip. Additionally, several shelter centers housing displaced people were targeted, and entire residential blocks were demolished, leaving many without shelter.

The occupation forces continued their policy of systematic killing. The death of a freed prisoner from the village of Abu Shukhaydam was documented, resulting from medical negligence during his captivity. This brought the total number of victims in the West Bank to 510 deaths and 5,000 wounded from October 7, 2023, to May 20, 2024.



Tuesday, May 21, 2024

The occupation army persisted in committing massacres and crimes in the Gaza Strip. Official Palestinian sources documented several massacres, detailing the number of deaths and wounded:

Regarding the continued targeting of the health system, it was documented that artillery shells and live bullets were fired at the reception and emergency department gate of Kamal Adwan Hospital. Patients and medical staff were forced to leave, but not all could evacuate, leaving their fate unknown.

The occupation forces continued their policy of systematic killing. The assassination of eight Palestinian citizens was documented during an assault on the city and camp of Jenin. This brought the total number of victims in the West Bank to 518 deaths and 5,000 wounded from October 7, 2023, to May 21, 2024.

Regarding the ongoing forced displacement, the occupation army targeted a group of displaced people as they left a shelter center in Jabalia camp, resulting in four deaths. Another attack on a house in Al-Zawaida, which housed displaced individuals, resulted in ten deaths and several injuries.

The occupation forces continued their policy of systematic killing. The assassination of three Palestinian citizens was documented during an assault on the city and camp of Jenin. This brought the total number of victims in the West Bank to 521 deaths and 5,000 wounded from October 7, 2023, to May 22, 2024.

The occupation army persisted in committing massacres and crimes in the Gaza Strip. Official Palestinian sources documented several massacres, detailing the number of deaths and wounded:


These incidents were recorded across the Gaza Strip, which faced both air and ground bombardment, as follows:

Regarding forced displacement, hundreds of displaced individuals left "Khalifa Bin Zayed" School in Beit Lahia due to nearby shelling. The occupation army also targeted "Ghazi Al Shawa" School in Beit Hanoun, which houses thousands of displaced people, with artillery shells, resulting in three injuries, including one severe injury.

The occupation forces continued their policy of systematic killing. The assassination of a Palestinian citizen was documented during an assault on the city and camp of Jenin. This brought the total number of victims in the West Bank to 522 deaths and 5,000 wounded from October 7, 2023, to May 23, 2024.

2. Political and Humanitarian Repercussions:

During the period covered by this report, the occupation army systematically and deliberately destroyed the health sector and hospitals, aiming to permanently eliminate health institutions. The intensified destruction specifically targeted hospitals in the northern Gaza Strip, rendering the health sector in Gaza and the northern governorates completely nonfunctional, unable to provide even secondary care services.





released Palestinian prisoners revealed that Israeli occupation authorities committed severe crimes, including arbitrary detention, enforced disappearance, torture, and inhumane and degrading treatment against thousands of Palestinian civilians. These actions were part of the genocide perpetrated by the occupation forces and affected women, children, the elderly, and displaced individuals during military attacks and raids on cities, camps, and various residential neighborhoods in the Gaza Strip.


