

**Israeli Genocide in Gaza  
Situation Report (No. 44)  
on the Israeli Aggression on Gaza**  
Covers the period from 13<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2024

# Introduction

This report documents the genocide perpetrated by the Israeli occupation in the Gaza Strip, meticulously tracking daily scenes from July 13 to July 22, 2024. It details the political and humanitarian repercussions, alongside the material and human losses suffered by Gaza due to the continuous aggression and blockade. Furthermore, the report covers the consequences of the aggression in the West Bank since October 7, 2023.



## 1. Daily Scenes

Saturday, July 13, 2024

The Israeli army continued its massacres and crimes in the Gaza Strip. Official Palestinian sources documented the number of massacres, deaths, and wounded victims as follows:

Regarding the continued targeting of displaced persons, artillery shelling near the tents of displaced persons in the Al-Mawasi area, west of Khan Yunis, resulted in two deaths and multiple injuries on July 23, 2024. An aerial bombardment targeting the UNRWA Gaza headquarters gate, which shelters displaced people in Gaza City, caused four deaths and several injuries.

On this day, the Israeli army committed a massacre at an UNRWA school sheltering displaced people in Al-Nuseirat camp, central Gaza Strip. The attack resulted in 15 deaths and 80 injuries.

In the West Bank, Israeli forces continued their policy of systematic killing. A Palestinian citizen from Kafr 'Aqab in the Jerusalem Governorate was assassinated. This brought the total number of victims in the West Bank to 574 deaths and 5,300 wounded from October 7, 2023, to July 14, 2024.

## Monday, July 15, 2024

The Israeli army persisted in committing massacres and crimes in the Gaza Strip. Official Palestinian sources documented the number of massacres, deaths, and wounded victims, as follows:

On this day, Israeli forces targeted displaced people in Al-Mawasi, Khan Yunis area, near the Jordanian Hospital, resulting in 17 deaths and 26 injuries. Additionally, a school sheltering displaced people in Al-Nuseirat camp was targeted, resulting in 23 deaths and 48 injuries.

In the West Bank, Israeli forces continued their policy of systematic killing. A Palestinian citizen in Al-Bireh was assassinated, raising the total number of victims in the West Bank to 575 deaths and 5,300 wounded from October 7, 2023, to July 16, 2024.

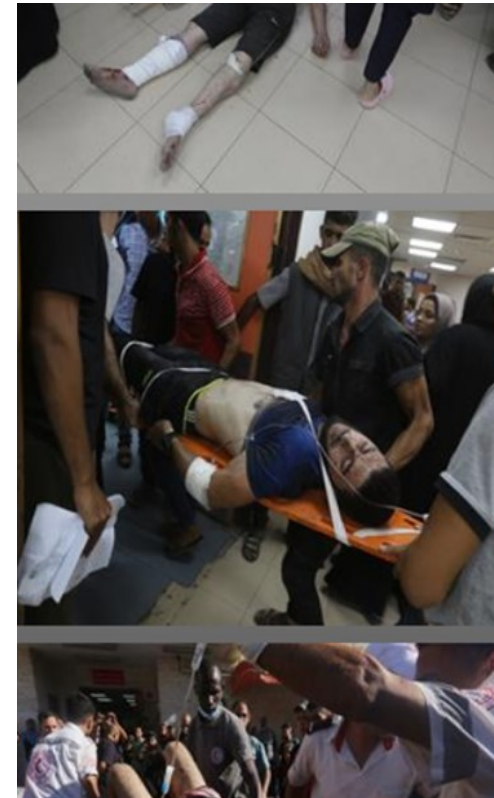

On this day, a residential building housing displaced people in the vicinity of Al-Nuseirat camp was targeted, resulting in one death and several injuries. Additionally, a drone bombed a civilian vehicle transporting displaced people, causing further deaths and injuries.

In On this day, Israeli forces bombed the gate of Al-Falah School, which shelters displaced people in the Al-Zaitoun neighborhood, east of Gaza City. It was also documented that new repressive methods were adopted against the displaced, including

establishing a gate controlling their movement, equipped with surveillance devices. Many displaced people were exposed to gunfire and assassination by Israeli soldiers.

In the West Bank, Israeli forces continued their policy of systematic killing. A Palestinian citizen in the town of Beit Ummar, Hebron district, was killed. This raised the total number of victims in the West Bank to 577 deaths and 5,350 wounded from October 7, 2023, to July 20, 2024.

## 2. Political and Humanitarian Repercussions:

The period covered by this report saw a deepening humanitarian crisis in Gaza, where humanitarian aid became a tool of oppression as all crossings were closed for 44 days, barring aid entry until July 22, 2024. This dire situation has doubled the risks to residents' lives, especially affecting children, the sick, and the wounded who struggle to access food and medical care.



Environmental impact assessments reveal that attacks by the occupying forces on residential areas have left Gaza with 39 million tons of rubble, equating to 107 kilograms per square meter. This has led to significant risks of soil, water, and air pollution. Collapsed water and sanitation systems have exacerbated the crisis, with sewage contaminating seas, soil, drinking water, and food sources. The use of munitions and harmful chemicals has further polluted soil and water resources.

In terms of political repercussions, there has been a disturbing escalation in the occupation forces' attacks on displaced persons' tents within designated "safe areas," notably near the Red Cross headquarters in Al-Mawasi Rafah. These assaults have resulted in numerous casualties, marking the fourth massacre of displaced individuals in Al-Mawasi in less than a month. This underscores the occupation's intent to perpetuate acts of genocide and forcibly displace Gaza's population. As the genocidal war reached its tenth month since October 7, 2023, the period covered by this report saw an escalation by the occupation army targeting all aspects of life in the Gaza and North Gaza governorates. The Israeli goal appears to be to make these areas unlivable and force their residents to be displaced in Southern Gaza.

In terms of political repercussions, official Palestinian sources emphasized the American role in perpetuating the genocide. The U.S. administration has contributed to the human tragedy and extensive damage to the Palestinian people by supplying the Israeli occupation with internationally banned weapons. These weapons, including bunker-buster bombs, GPS-guided bombs, white phosphorus bombs, and 200-pound explosive bombs, have resulted in over 38,500 deaths and 88,800 injuries. The occupation has used these weapons to carry out massacres against civilians, particularly children and women, and to destroy infrastructure.
