



Israeli Genocide in Gaza
Situation Report (No. 46)
on the Israeli Aggression on Gaza
Covers the period from 28th July to 6th August 2024

Introduction

This report documents the genocide carried out by the Israeli occupation in the Gaza Strip, detailing events observed and recorded between July 28 and August 6, 2024. It also examines the political and humanitarian repercussions, as well as the material and human toll resulting from the ongoing aggression and siege in Gaza. Additionally, the report addresses the consequences of the aggression in the West Bank since October 7, 2023.



1. Daily Scenes

■ Sunday, July 28, 2024

The Israeli occupation army continued its campaign of massacres and crimes in the Gaza Strip, with official Palestinian sources documenting the number of attacks, casualties, and injuries in the region:

Amid ongoing efforts to forcibly displace residents of the Gaza Strip, the occupation army carried out a massacre targeting children by bombing tents housing displaced families west of Khan Yunis in southern Gaza, resulting in numerous deaths and injuries.

On Regarding the continued attempts to impose forced displacement on the citizens of the Gaza Strip, on Monday 29, July 2024, the occupation forces escalated their actions, committing another massacre by targeting displaced individuals sheltering in Al-Firdous School in Al-Mawasi Rafah area, leading to five deaths and several injuries.

Regarding the continued attempts to impose forced displacement on citizens in the Gaza Strip, on Tuesday, July 30, 2024, intense artillery shelling struck the area surrounding Al-Awda Schools, where displaced people were taking refuge east of Khan Yunis. In the West Bank, the occupation forces continued their systematic killings, with assassinations documented in the Nablus and Hebron governorates. This brought the total number of victims in the West Bank to 592 deaths and 5,350 injuries since October 7, 2023.

The occupation forces targeted the health system and displaced individuals, bombing a residential house near Al-Durra Hospital in the Al-Tuffah area, east of Gaza City, resulting in several injuries. Additionally, injuries were reported at the Red Cross Hospital due to gunfire directed at tents housing displaced people in the Al-Mawasi area, west of Rafah.

On an ongoing attempt to forcibly displace citizens, the occupation forces bombed a school sheltering displaced people in Al-Shuja'iya neighbourhood of Gaza City, resulting in 15 deaths and dozens of injuries.

The violence persisted, as the occupation army bombed Al-Zeitoun School near Al-Shafi'i Mosque in the Al-Zeitoun neighborhood, southeast of Gaza City, which was housing displaced persons. Meanwhile, in the West Bank, the systematic killing continued, with the assassination of a Palestinian citizen in Nablus, bringing the total number of victims in the West Bank to 593 deaths and 5,350 injuries since October 7, 2023.

The occupation forces targeted Hamamah School in the Sheikh Radwan neighborhood, north of Gaza City, which was sheltering displaced people. This attack resulted in 17 deaths and 60 injuries. In the West Bank, nine Palestinians were assassinated in Tulkarm and Qalqilya, raising the death toll to 602, with 5,350 injured.

On this day, the occupation army targeted tents housing displaced people within the grounds of Al-Aqsa Hospital in Deir al-Balah, central Gaza Strip, leading to 5 deaths and 18 injuries. In the West Bank, a Palestinian citizen from Salfit was assassinated, increasing the death toll to 603 and injuries to 5,350 since October 7.

The occupation's assaults continued, with the killing of a Palestinian woman from Jenin documented. This brought the total number of deaths in the West Bank to 604 and injuries to 5,400 since October 7.

The occupation forces once again targeted tents housing displaced people in Deir al-Balah. In the West Bank, 12 Palestinians were assassinated in Tubas, Jenin, and Bethlehem, pushing the death toll to 616, with 5,400 injured since October 7, 2023.

2. Political and Humanitarian Repercussions:

The electricity infrastructure in Gaza faced extensive destruction, severely impacting distribution networks, facilities, and warehouses. This damage has worsened the electricity crisis, leading to the collapse of many related services. The ongoing crisis has brought about unprecedented challenges, including the spread of epidemics and infectious diseases like polio and meningitis, driven by pollution, lack of clean water, and inadequate prevention methods.

Politically, this period saw the exposure of severe crimes committed by occupation soldiers against Palestinian prisoners in Israeli prisons. Notably, a Palestinian prisoner was documented as having been raped in “Sde Teiman” prison, and another prisoner from Jabalia died as a result of brutal torture in the same facility.

In a related humanitarian context, the occupation army exhibited grossly degrading behavior towards the bodies of 89 deceased citizens from Gaza, who had been detained during mass killings in the Strip. The bodies, returned in a decomposed state, were distributed in just 35 burial shrouds, with 13 bodies in one burial shroud, 22 in another, and the remaining bodies scattered among several shrouds. This act is a profound insult to the dignity of the deceased and a stark violation of human values, with no clarity on the circumstances surrounding their detention and deaths.

3. Human Loss and Material Damage:
