



**Israeli Genocide in Gaza**  
**Situation Report (No. 47)**  
**on the Israeli Aggression on Gaza**  
Covers the period from 7<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> August 2024

# Introduction

This report chronicles the genocide carried out by the Israeli occupation in the Gaza Strip, detailing field events between July 7 and August 12, 2024. It also examines the political and humanitarian repercussions, as well as the material and human toll inflicted on the Gaza Strip due to the ongoing aggression and blockade. Additionally, the report covers the impacts of the aggression in the West Bank since October 7, 2023.



## 1. Daily Scenes

■ Wednesday, August 7, 2024

The occupation army continued its campaign of massacres and crimes in the Gaza Strip, as official Palestinian sources documented the number of massacres, deaths, and injuries:

On Wednesday, August 7, 2024, the occupation forces intensified their efforts to forcibly displace Gaza's citizens, launching an attack on a tent sheltering displaced people in the Abasan Al-Kabira area and the town of Bani Suheila in Khan Yunis, resulting in 9 fatalities.

In the West Bank, the occupation forces continued their systematic killings, with the assassination of Palestinian citizens in Tubas and Jenin being recorded. This brings the total number of victims in the West Bank to 618 deaths and 5,400 wounded from October 7, 2023 to August 7, 2024.

The occupation forces persisted in their efforts to forcibly displace Gaza's citizens. On this day, they targeted tents sheltering displaced people in the Al-Mawasi area of Khan Yunis, resulting in 11 deaths, including two children.

The occupation army carried out a horrific massacre by bombing the tents of displaced persons in the Al-Daraj neighborhood of Gaza City with three missiles, leading to 100 deaths and hundreds of injuries.

The occupation forces continued their campaign, targeting displaced persons' camps in Deir al-Balah in central Gaza, resulting in several injuries. In the West Bank, the systematic killing of Palestinian citizens persisted, with the assassination of residents in Jenin, raising the death toll to 620, with 5,400 wounded from October 7, 2023, to August 11, 2024.

## Monday, August 12 2024

The The occupation army continued its campaign of massacres and crimes in the Gaza Strip, with official Palestinian sources documenting the number of massacres, deaths, and injuries::

In the West Bank, the occupation forces' systematic killing policy led to the assassination of two Palestinian citizens in the town of Azzun, Qalqilya District, bringing the total number of victims in the West Bank to 621 deaths and 5,400 wounded from October 7, 2023, until August 12, 2024.

## 2. Political and Humanitarian Repercussions:

During the period covered by this report, it was revealed that the Israeli occupation army employed covert intelligence and espionage tactics aimed at gathering sensitive information on families, individuals, and locations within the Gaza Strip. These actions put civilians at significant risk of assassinations, massacres, and genocide. The operations involved deliberate contact with various families, where they were deceitfully asked to provide detailed information about their whereabouts, daily routines, and sleeping arrangements. To avoid raising suspicion, this information was falsely presented as being collected to provide humanitarian aid, such as cash or food parcels.

In a continuation of forced displacement efforts, the occupation army committed a horrific massacre at "Al-Tabaeen School" in Gaza City. This brutal attack resulted in the deaths of over 100 people and left dozens more injured as the displaced were directly targeted during dawn prayers. Due to the severity of the massacre and the overwhelming number of victims, medical teams, civil defense, and emergency responders were unable to recover all the bodies.

The report also highlights the negative role of international organizations, particularly documenting calls for the dismissal of the United Nations Special Rapporteur on Torture, Dr. Alice Jill Edwards. The calls stem from her failure to perform her duties effectively and objectively, especially concerning the grave violations against Palestinian prisoners and detainees in Israeli prisons and detention centers.



### 3. Human Loss and Material Damage:
